

Notification of the Use of Pesticides

This notice is to advise you that the following pesticides will be used at Haskell Elementary School

Imidacloprid	Centerfire 75 WSP	432-1332
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Location of the pesticide application: Lower Level Front Offices

Reason for the pesticide application: Termites

If an indoor application, the date and time it is planned:

DATE 5/1/15 TIME 3:30pm

If an outdoor application, 3 dates must be listed, in chronological order, on which the outdoor application may take place if the preceding date is canceled; and the time the application is scheduled to occur.

Description of the possible adverse effects of the pesticides as per the Material Safety Data Sheets for the pesticides to be used, if available: Centerfire 75 WSP: Caution: Hazards to humans and domestic animals. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Keep out of reach of children and animals.

Pesticide product label instructions and precautions related to Public Safety. Note: as required by law, we are advising you of the following statement: CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Keep children or pets away from treated area until dry. When treating adjacent to an existing structure, the applicator must check the area to be treated, and immediately adjacent areas of the structure, for visible and accessible cracks and holes to prevent any leaks or significant exposures to persons occupying the structure. People present or residing in the structure during application must be advised to remove their pets and themselves from the structure if they see any signs of leakage. After application, the applicator is required to check for leaks. All leaks resulting in the deposition of termiticide in locations other than those prescribed on this label must be cleaned up prior to leaving the application site. Do not allow people or pets to contact contaminated areas or to reoccupy contaminated areas of the structure until the clean up is completed

*The Office of Pesticide Programs of the United States Environmental Protection Agency has stated:
"Where possible, persons who potentially are sensitive, such as pregnant women, infants, and children, should avoid any unnecessary pesticide exposure."*

REMEMBER: Whenever a non-low impact pesticide is used on school property there is also a Restricted Entry Interval (REI) that begins when the pesticide application ends. This Restricted Entry Interval last for seven hours unless the product label uses NUMERIC LANGUAGE, e.g., 4hours or 12 hours; directing a longer or shorter period of time. If the product label does not discuss Restricted Entry the period of time defaults to seven (7) hours.
