GRADE TWO & THREE STUDENTS: BEGINNING MARCH 22


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- **Continue with phase-in approach, beginning with the primary grades**
 - 5 Day a Week In-Person Program; 1:19 Dismissal
 - **Precautions Taken**
 - Masked & spaced 6 ft. apart
 - Individual desk shields
 - Snack will be had outside or in the gymnasium
 - Custodians will sanitize room during this time.
 - Consulted School Physician, Local Health Department & updated our County as to the revised Plan

GRADE TWO & GRADE THREE STUDENTS

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- **Special Area classes will still be virtual for all students**
 - 100% Virtual students will continue to follow their regular schedule
 - For in-person students, they will take Art in their classroom, via the SmartBoard.
 - For in-person students, Physical Education, Technology & Music will be in the afternoons, 2:15 or 2:55. *(Music for Haskell Students ONLY)*

START DATE: MONDAY, MARCH 22, 2021

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- **Start Date: Monday, March 22, 2021 Phase 2 will begin**
 - Virtual students who are switching programs, will be receiving an email from their in-person teacher & principal.
 - **After this date, Grade 2 & 3 virtual students will not be able to switch to the in-person program until the start of the 4th Marking Period.**
 - If a virtual family would like to switch they will need to notify their principal by March 26th, in preparation for the 4th Marking Period.

GRADE TWO & GRADE THREE STUDENTS

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- **Borrowed Chromebooks can stay at home**
 - **If the class, school, or district had to switch to Virtual only instruction, the students will be following their new schedule.**
 - **Virtual option is still and will be available**
