



- The Amistad mandate requires social studies curriculum to incorporate African-American history, to show and recognize the integral part African-Americans in this nation's history.
- 6th Grade will focus on American History I
- 7th Grade will focus on American History II
- 8th Grade will focus on Ancient Civilization

Community Service Hours \rightarrow Expected to take part, as part of the regular school program

- 6th Grade: 10 Hours of Community Service Per Year
- **7**th **Grade:** 15 Hours of Community Service Per Year
- 8th Grade: 20 Hours of Community Service Per Year
