MUSIC CURRICULUM



- This curriculum is written with the firm understanding that music education is one of the basics – an essential set of concepts and skills for which everyone must develop proficiency.
- Skill-Based
- Interdisciplinary connections throughout every grade level (Pre-K-8)
- Learning about the world, past & present events, musicians, and through song.

General Music Pre-School: A year-long program meeting once a week for a minimum of thirty (30) minutes per session.

General Music Kindergarten: A year-long program meeting once a week for a minimum of forty (40) minutes per session.

General Music 1st-8th Grade: A half-year long program meeting once per week for a minimum of forty (40) minutes per session.

Choral Music Grades 6-8: Choruses meet once per week for forty (40) minutes per session before school.

Instrumental Music Grades 4-8: Students who participate in the instrumental program will be provided with individualized instrumental lessons (a maximum of 5 students per group), which are taught during the regular school day once a week for forty (40) minutes per session.

Instrumental Music Grades 4-8: In addition to instrumental lessons, at the discretion of the Band Director, Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced Band will be scheduled twice per week for forty (40) minutes per session before or after school.
