Grading

Rating Scale Grades K-2

4- Consistently meets grade level expectations, performs independently.

3- Steady progress towards expectations, understands concepts or skills, requires some guidance.

Grading (cont.)

2- Beginning to work toward expectations, demonstrates beginning understanding, requires frequent assistance.

1- Works below grade level expectations, difficulty grasping/retaining concepts, has difficulty with considerable assistance.

Classroom Celebrations

Must be store bought w/ ingredients listed.

Sugar CANNOT be the first ingredient

Consider alternative options such as coming in and reading a book to the class, playing a game or doing a craft.

Safety & Security

Parents may ONLY enter through the main entrance and must report to the Main Office to sign in and get a Visitor's Pass.

Fire and Evacuation Drills are each conducted one time per month.

Miscellaneous

Keep the office up to date with changes such as phone number, who is picking up, etc.

Medicine must be given to the nurse, cannot be kept in the backpack.

Cafeteria procedures in the beginning of the year.

Supplies

1. Rest Rug- A washable bath mat approx. 21" x 24" with a rubber backing
2. Smock for Art Activities- long-sleeved smock or old shirt that covers your child
3. Box of envelopes- Milk money and lunch money should be placed in separate sealed envelopes labeled w/ name and indicating use

4. Snacks - Snacks should be placed in a separate bag from your child's lunch.

5. Lunch- Please place your child's lunch in a labeled lunch box or bag.

6. Homework Supplies- The following items will be helpful: pencils, colored pencils, crayons, and glue sticks.
